You must complete three projects. All final projects should be in your Singing Revolution Project folder on Google Drive. The center box is mandatory for all students in Mr. K and Mr. Foley’s math classed. This is optional for students NOT in Mr. K or Mr. Foley’s math classes.

<p><b>Your Songlist</b> Create a list of 10 songs that are important to you/that you like/etc.</p> <p>Include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Title</li> <li>2. Artist</li> <li>3. One sentence explaining why you chose this song.</li> </ol> <p>You may use Google docs or slides.</p>	<p><b>Sentence Patterns &amp; Estonian Information</b> Using Google Slides, create a presentation. Each slide should have two parts:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. One sentence pattern featuring a specific pattern and information about <i>The Singing Revolution</i>.</li> <li>2. A picture corresponding with the information about <i>The Singing Revolution</i>. You will have at least 15 slides. A title slide and all 14 sentence patterns (in order).</li> </ol>	<p><b>Estonia Today</b> For this project you may work alone or create a group project.</p> <p>Idea #1: Create a list called “What You Should Know About Modern Estonia”</p> <p>Idea #2: Create a newsletter/newspaper about recent events in Estonia.</p> <p>Whatever format you use, you should be able upload this document into Google Drive.</p>
<p>Create a list of 10 protest songs.</p> <p>Include</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Title</li> <li>2. Artist</li> <li>3. A brief explanation of the protest and the role of the song. This must be summarized and in your own words.</li> </ol> <p>The Estonian song <i>Ilus Maa</i> must one of the listed songs.</p> <p>If you use Google Slides, you may include pictures from the protest.</p>	<p>Human Rights Infographic</p>	<p>Art Option</p> <p>Create an Estonian flag. You may use fabric or paper.</p> <p>When you finish the artwork, create a document for Google Drive with the history of the flag and the meaning of the three colors. You do not have to summarize this information. You may copy and paste – but make sure to include the website/s you use.</p>
<p>Using your notes, write 10 multiple-choice questions and one short essay question for the Estonia Unit.</p> <p>*Use Google Forms. When this assignment is perfect, we will post it on the English website and students may complete it for extra credit.</p>	<p>Create a Venn diagram comparing Josef Stalin and Mikhail Gorbachev.</p>	<p>Create your own project. Talk with Ms. Hutton about your idea.</p>
